## What is the issue?

Introduction shows clear understanding of the issue

## Thesis statement: your position or opinion

Presented in a precise and logical statement

### Supporting reason #1

Logical reason, details, examples, evidence

### Supporting reason #2

Logical reason, details, examples, evidence

### Supporting reason #3

Logical reason, details, examples, evidence

## Opposing viewpoints: arguments that differ from yours

(the other side of the issue – yes, there always is one!)

Various arguments and implications are evaluated and responded to

## Conclusion

Summarize the issue, re-state thesis, Re-state strong supporting statement

– YOUR STRONGEST ARGUMENT!
